Notably, the grant will also cover the travel expenses of Dr. Adebayo's students to Prof. Liu's laboratory at NTU, providing them with a unique opportunity for hands-on learning and international exposure.

### TOP BOWEN MEDICAL GRADUATES SECURE IMMEDIATE JOBS AS 56 NEW DOCTORS ARE INDUCTED BY MDCN



The Medical and Dental Council of Nigeria (MDCN) has inducted 56 new medical graduates from Bowen University for the 2023/24 academic session, bringing the total number of Bowen's inducted medical professionals to 374 since the programme's inception in the 2008/09 academic session. The induction ceremony, held on Thursday, August 22, 2024, marked the university's 9th MBBS induction.

During the event, the Provost of the College of Health Sciences, Prof. Olufemi Awotunde, emphasized that the graduates had received comprehensive training in both medical science and the art of healing. Representing the Registrar of the Council, Dr. Fatima Kyari, was Dr. Henry Okwuokenye, who praised Bowen's medical graduates for their excellent contributions to Nigeria's healthcare sector. He highlighted the unique combination of godliness and medical education at Bowen, which sets its graduates apart, leading the Council to advocate for an increased admission quota in medicine for the university. He also urged the new doctors to pursue advanced studies and reach the heights of their specializations.

Guest speaker Dr. Adebukola Abiola, Medical Director of Preston Healthcare in New York, commended Bowen for producing impactful medical personnel. In his lecture, "Medical Practice in the Era of Artificial Intelligence," Dr. Abiola emphasized the necessity for medical professionals to integrate Al knowledge into their practice, warning that failure to do so could result in job losses due to the transformative impact of Al in healthcare.

Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Jonathan Babalola FAS FRSC, reaffirmed Bowen University's commitment to producing morally upright, well-trained medical professionals. He encouraged the new inductees to collaborate effectively with other health sector professionals for the advancement of healthcare. He also called on the Federal Government to support private universities, which would boost their ability to produce skilled graduates for the nation.

In recognition of outstanding performance, the management of Bowen University offered immediate employment to the top three graduating students: Dr. Alaba Omotoke lyimide, Dr. Adeyemo Ayodeji, and Dr. Osikoya Oluwatimilehin.

#### NRF-RATED NANOTECHNOLOGY EXPERT VISITS BOWEN, SETS STAGE FOR FUTURE PARTNERSHIP

On August 16, 2024, Bowen University had the honor of hosting Professor Samuel Oluwafemi, a distinguished National Research Foundation-rated researcher from the University of Johannesburg, South Africa. The visit marked a significant milestone for Bowen University as it continues to strengthen its international research collaborations.

Professor Oluwafemi was warmly received by the Vice-Chancellor. Professor Jonathan Babalola FAS FRSC, along with the Directorate of Research and Strategic Partnerships, led by Professor Ademola Ayeleso and Dr. James Akinbode. As an expert the field of nanotechnology. Professor Oluwafemi delivered an insightful presentation titled "Sustaining the Macro World and Economy through the NANO World: The Wonders of Nanomaterials" and engaged in an interactive session, with Bowen University's researchers, further enriching the academic experience.

This visit is expected to pave the way for the development of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Bowen University and the University of Johannesburg, fostering deeper collaboration and shared research initiatives between the two institutions.

From August 5 to 7, 2024, Bowen University held the BOWEN-RSC Research and Community Development Workshop at the Timothy Olagbemiro Library, Iwo, Nigeria. Themed "Exploring Global Opportunities with a Good Degree in Chemical Sciences," the event attracted participants from across Nigeria and featured renowned speakers from academia and industry.

The workshop was chaired by the Vice-Chancellor, Professor Jonathan Babalola, alongside hosts Professor Abimbola A. Owoseni, Provost of the College of Agriculture, Engineering and Science, and Professor Godwin Olutona, Head of the Industrial Chemistry Programme. The keynote address was delivered by Professor John A. Gladysz from Texas A&M University, USA, who explored career and research opportunities in chemical sciences.

Other notable speakers included Professor Aderemi O. Ogunfowokan and Professor Grace O. Ogunlusi from Obafemi Awolowo University, Dr. Clement O. The event featured breakout sessions, networking opportunities, and a formal dinner, bringing together 91 physical and 7 virtual participants, including students from secondary schools, universities, and colleagues from Bowen University. The Royal Society of Chemistry, UK, generously funded the workshop, further strengthening Bowen University's commitment to global research and collaboration.


