Olayinka Adekinju, a professor of Economics and a Fellow of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria, has advocated inward focus to revive the Nigerian economy. In her recent inaugural lecture at Bowen, she emphasised the need to enhance corporate performance by addressing internal and external factors. In her paper entitled 'Act of God, or Looking inwards: Unraveling the Drivers of Corporate Performance in Nigeria,' Adenikinju highlighted issues in corporate governance due to poor data quality and suggested policy changes by the Nigerian government to tackle challenges exchange rate volatility and inconsistent policies. 
